May 3rd - Derby Day 4 Autism Watch Party

The Derby Day 4 Autism Watch Party starts at 3:30 pm at the University of Central Florida's John Euliano Park (baseball park). The event is open to guests 21 and older and offers an afternoon of unlimited food and drinks, live Kentucky Derby viewing on jumbo screens, a live auction, a 50/50 raffle, a Winner's Circle photo opportunity, music by DJ Gonzo, dancing and more. Attendees are encouraged to wear Derby-inspired attire. General admission is \$125, with VIP tickets available for \$150.

According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), 1 in 31 children is diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder. Since the fundraisers inception in 2007, Loyal Source has provided more than \$2.5 million benefiting Providing Autism Links & Support (PALS), the supporting non-profit for the University of Central Florida's Center for Autism & Related Disabilities (UCF-CARD). Funds raised will support over 24,000 individuals and families across Central Florida by delivering vital community programs, therapeutic support, social groups, inclusive activities and more.
